(a) to (b) The details of India's overall export (Merchandise + Services) during the last three months are attached at Annexure-I.

Some of the sectors where dip has been seen are in petroleum products exports which was on account of decline of global prices in petroleum and in gems and jewellery segment which was impacted due to geo-political tensions.
