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2. The above nodal officers will pursue with States/UTs for boosting exports as follows:-

- i. To be the single contact point for all matters related to the State / UT concerning the Department of Commerce.
- ii. Pursue and assist in formulation/implementation of 'Export Strategy' by the State Government / UT, which should, inter-alia, include an action plan containing:-
 - State's / UT's policy initiatives for promotion of standards, certification, and trace back to meet international norms, including setting up of testing facilities.
 - Strategy and policy initiatives by the State Government / UT to improve its export logistics.
 - Strategy and policy initiatives for promotion of services export by the State Government / UT.
 - Policy initiative to promote value addition in the exports of goods from the State / UT.
 - Policy initiative to promote organic cultivation and certification.
 - Address infrastructure constraints to facilitate faster movement of goods.
 - Streamline taxation refund issues such as GST/VAT/State level cess.
- iii. Review and pursue preparation and implementation of the Agriculture Export Policy, State Action Plans and the District as Export Hubs Initiative with the State Government.
- iv. Provide guidance to the Regional Authority of DGFT in their State/UT and function as local support to their State Government / UT in all matters related to Trade and Commerce.
- v. Participate in meetings of bodies constituted by the State/ UT to promote exports in the State/ State Level Export Promotion Committee (SLEPC) meetings as a representative of the Department.
- vi. Be a part of the delegation accompanying the Hon'ble Commerce Minister and Commerce Secretary during the visit to the State/ UT.
- vii. Facilitate/coordinate various initiatives in the State/ UT through various Ministries/organizations concerning the export sectors of the State/ UT.
- viii. Interact with the concerned officials of the State/ UT to identify gaps in infrastructure, examine and recommend proposals and monitor the progress of export infrastructure projects in the State, including all ongoing projects funded by the Dept. of Commerce through TIES.
- ix. Pursue completion/follow-up of projects under the erstwhile ASIDE Scheme and the Trade Infrastructure for Export Scheme (TIES).
- x. Participation in meetings with the Exporters/Export Organizations in the State / UT.
- xi. Represent the Department of Commerce in all meetings with the State Government Ministers/ Officials.

3. Nodal Officers should also ensure regular bi-monthly meetings of the Export Commissioners and other State Government officials with exporters from their respective State / UT and participate in such meetings. The meetings can be scheduled on a pre-determined day of the month.
