Buyer Seller Meet for Saffron and Other Spices of Jammu & Kashmir

The unique ecosystem of union territory of Jammu & Kashmir has resulted in the evolution of a diverse farming system in the region, which boasts the production of cereals, coarse grain, pulses, wide range of fruits, vegetable and spices. Jammu & Kashmir Union Territory of India is famous for producing some unique spices, viz. Saffron, Hill Garlic and Kashmiri Red Chilli.

Saffron is one of the costliest spices and has strong demand in national and international market. Over the past four years, the average price of saffron in domestic market has been found to increase by 187%, i.e., from Rs 79,500 / kg in 2020-21 to Rs 166,562 / kg in 2023-24. Kashmir Saffron got the Geographical Indication (GI) tag in 2020. The demand for Kashmir saffron has been steadily increasing since receipt of the Geographical Indication tag.

Spices Board (Ministry of commerce & Industry, Govt. of India) the flagship organization for the development and worldwide promotion of Indian Spices has been spearheading activities for promotion and facilitation of spices trade by strengthening linkages at various levels of the spices sector.

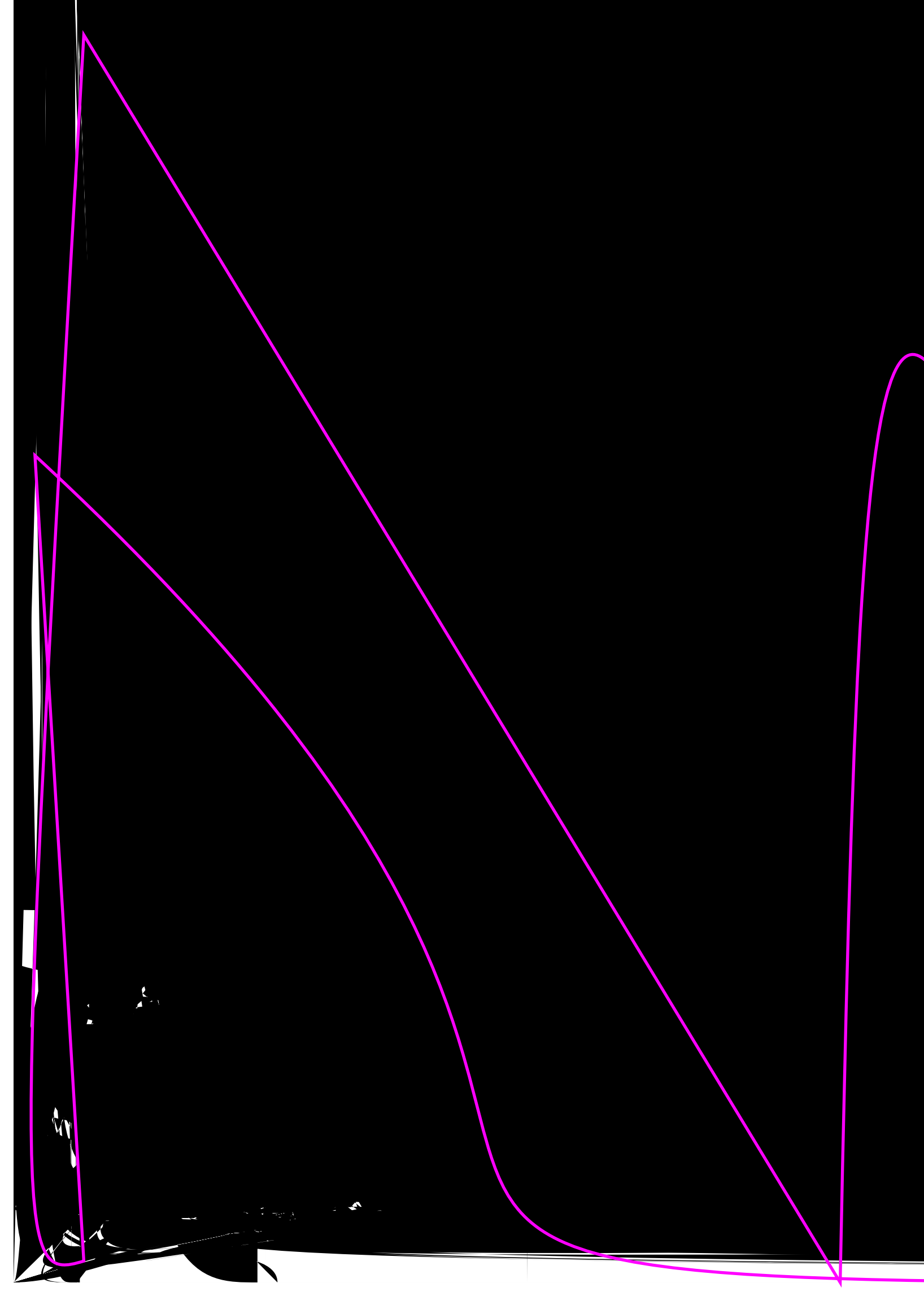
