I am happy to learn that The Plastics Export Promotion Council (PLEXCONCIL) is organizing its Export Award Function to honour the top exporters for the year 2006-07 in Mumbai on 24th November, 2007.

Exports from the Plastics sector have crossed US Dollars 3 billion in the last financial year and registered a growth of over 21%, with the plastic raw material exports constituting more than 50% of the total exports from the plastics sector. Export of plastic processed goods, which registered an overall growth in exports of around 8.8% in the last financial year, however needs to be strengthened further. The Council's proposed project under the Market Access Initiative (MAI) Scheme for tapping the vast potential for plastic consumer items in USA and the proposed feasibility study of setting up dedicated Plastic Parks, are some of the efforts being made towards increasing exports of finished plastic products in the long term. Small enterprises constitute a large proportion of the membership of the Council. Therefore, Council has a greater responsibility towards providing them facilities which they may not be able to afford or which can be offered as common facilities in clusters. Plastics sector is a growing segment of modern industry and must be further enriched with support in terms of designs, new applications and synergies with activities of other councils. I am sure, the Council and its members will also look at some of these aspects in following years.

I congratulate all the Export Award Winners, and extend my best wishes to PLEXCONCIL in their efforts to promote exports in a highly competitive international market. I also convey my good wishes to all the other members of the Council, and hope they draw inspiration from the Export Award Winners to make intensive efforts to ensure the distinction in the coming years.

I feel privileged to be amongst you all here today on the occasion of our Export Award Function – the last one that I shall be addressing during my current tenure as the Chairman of the Council. It gives me great pleasure to welcome you all to this prestigious event where the Top Performers in the export arena from the Indian plastic industry will be honoured. I must not forget the top exporters from the Human Hair and its products sector which is attached to our Council who will also be honoured.

At the outset, friends, I would like to welcome you all to this function today and hope that this event will be a motivating factor to both the export award winners and other fellow exporters to scale greater heights in the exports arena. I would like to accord a special welcome to Mr B K Handique, Honourable Minister of State for Chemicals & Fertilizers and Parliamentary Affairs, Government of India who has once again found time out of his otherwise busy schedule and is amidst us here today to honour the export Award winners. His presence here is very much indicative of his own and his Ministry's conviction to accord a high priority to plastic exports.

I would like to welcome all the dignitaries from the Government and other export agencies who have always extended us their best co-operation and support in our endeavour to boost exports from the Indian plastic industry. I must also accord a special welcome to friends from the media who have always been disseminating our messages, programmes and achievements to the masses.

Friends, on the export front we are doing reasonably well. In 2006-2007, as per the returns filed by our members, we achieved an export of about 3187 million US Dollars as against a target of 3450 million US Dollars registering a growth of about 21% which is fairly good. However, while we have an excellent export figure before us, I must add that the exports

of plastics raw material alone increased from about 55% to 60% of our total exports last fiscal.

I would once again like to draw your attention to what the Executive Director of M/s Reliance Industries Ltd., Mr. Nikhil Meswani said when he addressed our Golden Jubilee Function gathering in Mumbai on July 15, 2005. He categorically mentioned in his address that while he was happy to note that his company figured in the top exporters of Plexconcil, he was saddened to point out that the plastic processing is losing an opportunity of 300 million dollars through value addition on the raw material that they were exporting. Friends, I would like to once again reiterate that we must act fast to actually give a boost to exports from plastic items takes a front seat must also add that the growth that we have the Indian plastic industry. Plastic exports has reduced from about 45% to registered in processed plastic warrants immediate action from plastic about 9% which all the processors all over India.

I am proposing a target of 3827 million US dollars to sustain a growth rate of at least 20%. We have crossed the 3-billion dollar mark much faster than what we expected. We need to do a lot more to gain a respectable share in the world market and I look forward to all of us working together towards this end.

Through a few figures which will highlight Friends, let me just run through a few figures to exports. Germany, USA, Belgium where we stand when it comes to exports of Chapter 39 plastic items in and China were the top countries accounting for about 43% of world plastic exports the calendar year 2006. In 2006, 18 out of the 233 countries which was about 375 billion US Dollars in 2006. 18 out of the 233 countries account for about 80% of the total exports of 375 billion US Dollars. Among the Asian tigers included in these 18 countries are China, Japan, Korea, Taiwan, Singapore and Thailand. Even Malaysia is above India with exports of about 4.5 billion US Dollars. While we intend to do an in-depth study to evolve an effective export promotion strategy for the Indian plastic sector, these are only indicators that justify this study and an eye opener for us that we still have a long way to go considering the world plastics discuss and point out to China and how we achieved so far. All forums against this country. However, data indicates that smaller countries like Thailand and Malaysia are also well ahead of us which follows that we must take lessons from these countries as well.

The beginning of this financial year has witnessed an appreciating rupee trend which apparently is generally having an adverse effect on our exports. On one hand the appreciating rupee is an indicator that our economy is performing very well, for the exporting community it is something that is playing adversely on their cash flow in rupee terms. I must compliment the Government of India for having positively acted based on the plea made by the exporting community by and large in terms of increasing some DEPB rates and reducing the interest rates by two percentage points to certain industry segments and more importantly the SMEs. I am of the opinion that all of us must gear up to manage our foreign exchange risks very effectively. We can no longer bank on the appreciating Dollar for bettering our cash flow in a liberalized market oriented economy. As the supply of dollar increases both in terms of exports, foreign investments and remittances by NRIs, the demand for the dollar will witness a reducing trend thereby further strengthening the rupee vis-à-vis the dollar. One of the suggestions that we have strongly represented to the Government is to free the EEEFC accounts so that balances therein can be used for foreign investments, fixed deposits and any other use that an Indian rupee is put to in India till the time the Indian Rupee is made fully convertible some day or the other in the near future. We also need to educate ourselves in the various tools available for foreign exchange risk management to cover such risks and optimize the rupee realizations on exports. To begin with, the Council had arranged a workshop on Foreign Exchange Risk Management this year and I was really perturbed at the response which was even far off from being termed as lukewarm. Please use the Council's platform for effective export promotion.

The Government's well-conceived Market Access Initiative or the MAI is an excellent vehicle for us to gain better access in both the short and long run and will go a long way in withstanding competition and facing other adverse market forces like the appreciating rupee as well. You will recall that our project under this initiative was among one of the earlier approvals granted by the Department of Commerce. This project was aimed at tapping the over 5-billion US Dollar market for plastic consumer items in the USA which in the first phase involved a Market Study. Based on the Market Study the Council embarked upon the second phase of actually implementing the recommendations in the study which involved setting up of display centres, warehouses, participation in trade fairs and publicity campaigns.

Unfortunately, the second phase never took off due to the poor response from the members. Subsequently, we also felt that we were being too

ambitious in terms of adopting an integrated approach by trying to set up display centres, warehouses and other activities at the same time. It was felt that this could be done in stages. One of the main recommendations of the study to withstand competition was to resort to direct marketing which this project was aiming at.

I am pleased to announce that the Council has now decided to implement the project in stages. Setting up of a display centre in and around Los Angeles and other related activities has been approved by the Department of Commerce and we shall be implementing the same in 2008-2009. Depending on the results of this initial stage, warehouse will be set up in and around Los Angeles and this concept will be expanded to other locations in the USA as per the Market Study that has been conducted. Friends, I urge all of you in the plastic consumer items sector to avail of this golden opportunity which will provide you enough opportunity to set up a base in the USA for direct marketing by surpassing the bulk importers and marketing your ware directly to wholesalers and retailers. In this manner you will be better equipped to withstand competition and other adverse market forces. Your co-operation and support is a must to help us serve you better.

Friends, I would not like to take much of your time and would like to end by requesting all of you to join hands by working together with a common end of enhancing exports from the plastics sector.

Mr Rathod's flair to put their "FLAIR" writing instruments round the globe induced him to associate himself with the export promotion programmes of the Council. He participated in various export promotion activities including the memorable Latin American delegation in 1999. His export efforts found appropriate rewards when his company won the Council's Export Award several times from 1983 onwards and subsequently continuously from 2001-2002 to 2005-2006 in the second position.

Mr Rathod's involvement with exports and the Council motivated him to get elected to the Committee of Administration in the year 1999-2000 and ascended to the post of Vice Chairman for 2001-2003 and finally the Chairman for 2003-2005.

In recognition of his contributions and services to the exporting fraternity in the plastic industry, the Council honours Mr Vimalchand Rathod with this citation at the hands of Mr B K Handique, Honourable Minister of State for Chemicals & Fertilizers and Parliamentary Affairs on this Twenty Fourth day of November 2007 in Mumbai.
