In June 2011, Turkey imposed a definitive safeguard duty on import of PET having a viscosity number exceeding 78ml/g from various countries including India. The safeguard duty was for a period of three years, and the tariffs for the three years were 8.0%, 7.5% and 7.0%, respectively. In October 2014, Turkey decided to prolong the safeguard measures by another three years. The safeguard duty for the three years were 6.75%, 6.65% and 6.55%, respectively.

In July 2016, Ukraine imposed a definitive safeguard duty on import of Flexible porous plates, blocks and sheets of polyurethane foams from various countries including India. The safeguard duty was set at 13.09%, 12.44% and 11.81% for the next three years. In July 2019, Ukraine announced that it was extending the safeguard duty for another three years. The safeguard duty was set at 11.22%, 10.66% and 10.13% for the three years.

In February 2018, Turkey imposed a definitive safeguard duty on import of toothbrushes from various countries including India. The rate of duty was set at USD 0.23, USD 0.22 and USD 0.21 per piece for the next three years. In June 2020, Turkey initiated a review of the definitive safeguard duty imposed on import of toothbrushes.

In April 2021, Indonesia imposed a definitive safeguard duty on import of Expansible Polystyrene from various countries including India. The safeguard duty was set at 12%, 11% and 10% for the three years.
